Charlie the Crayon and his Mum arrived at the park. Charlie was excited as it was his first time there. He wanted to play and make lots of friends.

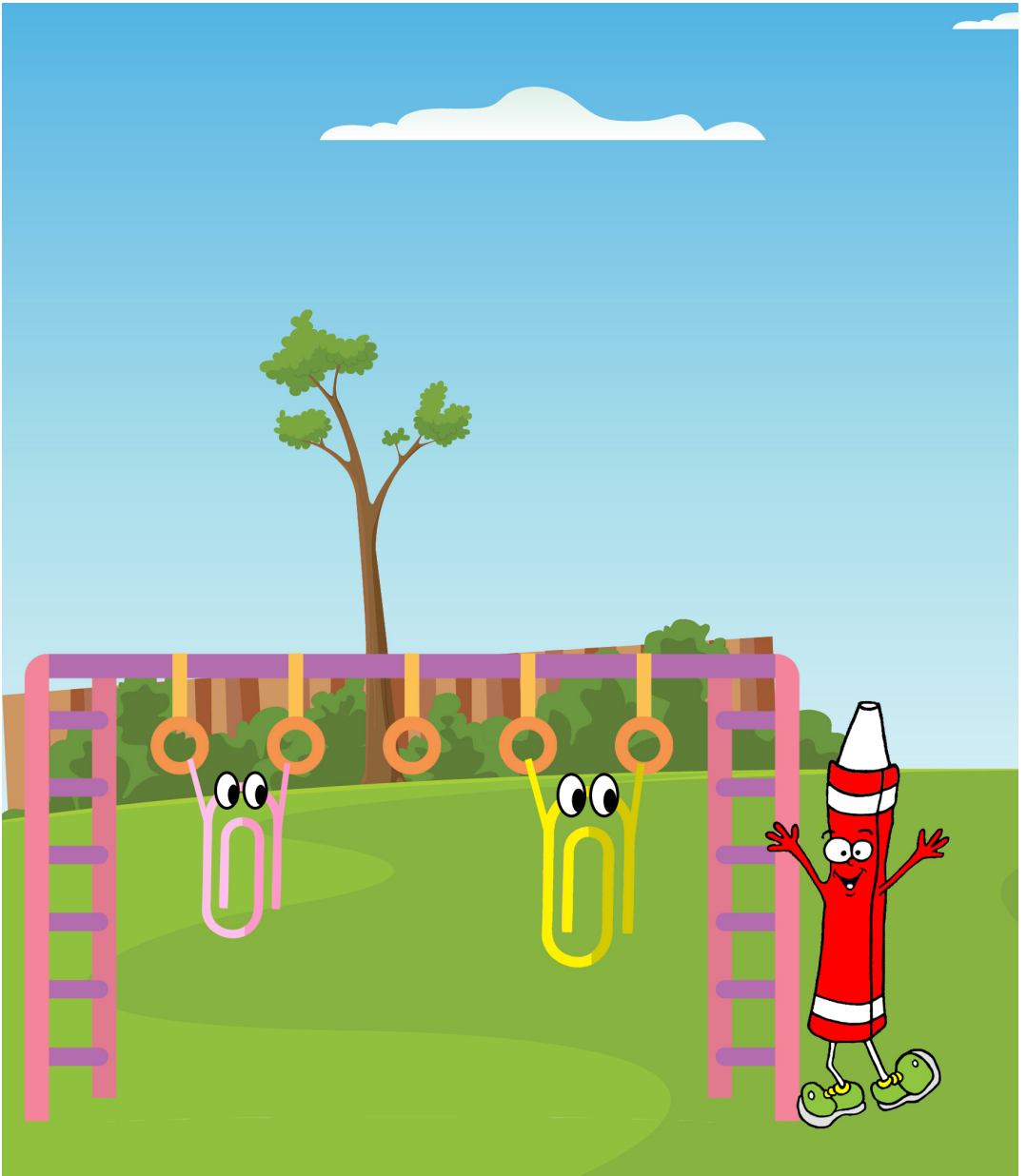
